Why are you running for Mayor and what do you hope to accomplish if elected/re-elected?*

Ellen: I was born for a time like this in San Francisco. I've been a resident and worker here since 1986. Embracing Christianity in 1993 at the San Francisco Evangelical Free Church, the Coalition for Good Neighborhoods nominated me for San Francisco Mayor in 2018 and 2019. In 2024, I responded to God's call to stand for San Francisco, California, and our nation. Mission -- Vision -- Action! It's time for God's Kingdom warriors to reclaim San Francisco and speak the TRUTH. "If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and heal their land. Returning to God is the SOLUTION to heal the homeless, transform drug dealers, revive criminals, remove career politicians, empower children and youth, and restore the lost and sick.

When you vote me in, I will be in the mayor's office in January 2025, top 3:

1. Audit all income and expenses, contracts, and non-profit agencies.--- Set up a non-city paid dept, invite retirees to do the audit, trace the money back to return to each community, organized by residents, benefit children, youth, parents, seniors, workers, and residents. Money back to business.

How do you describe yourself politically?

What issues and policy areas do you want to immediately work on if elected to office?

Ellen: 1. Audit all income and expense, contracts and non-profits, trace the money back, and re-direct resources to benefit SF residents.

2. Shelter the homeless, clear out all the homeless off the streets, free the dying lost souls / homeless from the devil: homeless scam! The business will come back. Jobs will come back.

My new team will be having public hearings day/night in the first 6 months. I plan to work 7 days a week to collaborate with people who are sick and tired of everything that has been going on in San Francisco for the last 10 years. We need to return the power to the People. We will do a needs assessment to understand each community's needs and train regular residents to stand for their rights. Be the voice for the voiceless.

BALLOT MEASURE POSITIONS

Please state your position on the following San Francisco ballot measures from the March 5th, 2024 election.

Proposition A*

Proposition A on the March 5, 2024 ballot in San Francisco was an affordable housing bond measure. It proposed issuing up to \$300 million in general obligation bonds to fund the acquisition, construction, and rehabilitation of affordable housing. This included housing for low- to moderate-income households, seniors, and those experiencing homelessness due to street violence, domestic violence, abuse, sexual assault, human trafficking, or other trauma.

The measure aimed to increase and preserve affordable housing without raising property taxes. It also included provisions for independent citizen oversight and annual financial audits to ensure transparency and accountability. Supporters emphasized the urgent need for affordable housing in San Francisco, particularly for vulnerable populations such as LGBTQ+ youth and victims of domestic violence.

Proposition B*

Proposition B was a Charter Amendment aiming to allocate funds for hiring and retaining police officers and establish a new minimum staffing requirement. This would only take effect if voters approved a new tax or repurposed an existing tax.

If a tax specifically to fund the "Police Full Staffing Fund" was approved by voters, Prop B would have set a minimum staffing level for ten years, with the provision that it would automatically expire after that period unless renewed by the voters.

Proposition C*

San Francisco Proposition C, on the March 5th, 2024 ballot, sought to provide a real estate transfer tax exemption for commercial properties converted to residential use. Specifically, this measure aimed to incentivize the conversion of vacant office spaces into housing by exempting these properties from the city's high transfer tax rates, which are 5.5% to 6% for properties valued over \$10 million. The measure required a simple majority to pass and ultimately received about 53% of the vote.

Ellen: All SF policies are created by only one party without checks and balances. We have NOT had a government for many years. Proposition D*

San Francisco Proposition D, on the March 5, 2024 ballot, aimed to amend the city's ethics laws. Key changes included:

1. **Expanded Gift Restrictions:** Barred more types of gifts to city officials, especially from those attempting to influence or do business with the city.
2. **Enhanced Disclosure Requirements:** Imposed stricter conflict of interest disclosures and penalties for non-compliance.
3. **Increased Ethics Training:** Required ethics training for over 4,000 city employees in decision-making roles.

4. **Standardized Gift Rules:** Removed exceptions and standardized rules regarding gifts and non-work activities

The measure received strong support from the San Francisco Ethics Commission and passed with significant voter approval, reflecting a public demand for more stringent and transparent governance practices in the city.

Ellen: In my own experience and as a translator for many government employees, the SF Ethics Commission is the most UN-ethical dept. They do as they said not as they do. Proposition E*

San Francisco Proposition E, on the March 5, 2024 ballot, aimed to expand SFPD's powers. Key points included:

1. **Surveillance Tools:** Allowed use of drones, license plate readers, and more cameras without prior approval from the Police Commission.
2. **Paperwork Reduction:** Let officers use body-camera footage instead of detailed reports for certain use-of-force incidents.
3. **Eased Pursuit Policies:** Lowered the threshold for high-speed chases to reasonable suspicion of felonies or violent misdemeanors.
4. **Community Feedback:** Required the Police Commission to seek community input before new rules.

Supporters said it would increase police efficiency; opponents argued it reduced accountability and oversight. It was passed by San Francisco voters.

How did you vote on this proposition?

Ellen: SF police have been powerless, and hopeless themselves due to failing leadership. Many people work in the police dept. Just to get paid so they can pay bills. For the police to function, we have to have backup systems to put criminals in. We have to allow the police to be police, not to set up many blocks to cripple the police to do their job. In 2022, when London Breed wrongfully terminated 200 unvaccinated police, then we know we don't have a government for the police to do their job. When I am in the Mayor's office, I will return the power to the People to work with the police on communication, learning common laws and the US Constitution to protect our public from the un-repent, un-willing to change criminals. Criminals will be punished according to common laws, laws of the good and moral, not threats. Everyone makes mistakes and everyone deserves a second chance. Proposition F*

Proposition F would make drug screening and substance abuse treatment a requirement for single adults receiving cash assistance from the City, excluding families and seniors.

Previously, individual adults with housing could receive up to \$712 per month, while homeless individuals could receive \$109 per month plus in-kind benefits like shelter and food.

Proposition F did not change the cash assistance amount for individuals addicted to drugs but required them to undergo drug screening and substance abuse treatment to receive it.

Proposition G*

Proposition G was a policy declaration that urged the San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD) to offer Algebra 1 to students by 8th grade and to support the development of SFUSD's math curriculum.

What are your plans to encourage and empower the Filipino Community in the Democratic political process?

Ellen: Our US constitution does not have the word “Democracy” but is a form of Republic. I used to be a Democrat for more than 22 years. When God opened my spiritual eyes about Democrat Party stands for, I changed my party now to Republican. Democrat leaders support criminals coming through open borders, public funds to kill little human beings, free drugs, and free needles to support drug dealers, laws for others but not for them, two-tier systems, etc. Most Asian democrats do not know they think like Republicans but misuse them by Democratic party leaders. What achievement are you most proud of in life?
