1. What inspired you to run for public office, and what positive changes do you hope to bring to your district/state if elected?*

Ellen: I was nominated to run for San Francisco Mayor in 2018 and 2019. This year 2024, God called me to run for San Francisco Mayor. I am the Voice so people can have a choice. 2. Please identify the top three critical issues facing your state, and how do you envision solving them to benefit the communities in your state?*

When I am in the Office, we will utilize and work with property owners to release their empty buildings to save San Francisco. 2. Crimes: Crimes impacted many businesses closed and left San Francisco As a pro-life woman of God and a Family Social Worker, I believe in a second chance at life. I believe we are facing a spiritual battle in San Francisco. We are all sinners and all of us make mistakes. I believe incarceration is necessary

for criminals, who are violent and endanger society. For those who are not at risk to society, but mentally ill or unhealthy individuals, we should place them with employment training programs, provide them job training to work their life out, and help them by training them with survival skills. I personally our current prison system is NOT working to help people for second chance at life. Many of the return criminals committed the same crimes due to basic needs such as stealing to survive. As a new Republican San Francisco Mayor, I will assess each individual's needs and strengths to train them to be independent, so they can live a life according to God's will in them. I do street ministry with ex-drug dealers, ex-criminals, ex-prostitute, etc. But they renew their life because they are willing to repent and turn from their wicked ways.
